

WADSWORTH MAGNET SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

All grade levels wear. Scholars are expected to wear the uniform correctly and with pride. Attention to one's personal appearance is a matter of self-discipline and is expected of all scholars. The proper wearing of the uniform is imperative **No attire or article of clothing is to be added to the uniform policy as indicated here.** All articles of clothing MUST be school-approved attire.

At all times, scholars must observe high standards of neatness and cleanliness. Scholars failing to comply with the uniform code will have their parents contacted to bring uniform into compliance. Repeated violations of the uniform policy may result in detention and possible the removal of the academic program. For safety and security, scholars must wear the school uniform in its entirety. The principal, assistant principals, and teachers are the final judges of uniform appropriateness or correctness. The decisions they make are final.

COLORS: NAVY BLUE/KHAKI (BOTTOM) WHITE/YELLOW/NAVY (SHIRT)

Female Uniform:

- Polo Shirts: White, Yellow, or Navy Blue
- Khaki or navy-blue slacks, only
- Khaki or navy-blue skirt or skorts (skirts are to be worn no shorter than 3" above knee)
- Shirts MUST be tucked

Honors Day Attire:

 White blouse along with khaki/navy/black pants or skirt/skort

Male Uniform:

- Polo Shirts: White, Yellow, or Navy Blue
- Khaki or navy-blue slacks (pants must be worn on the waist with a belt)
- Shirts MUST be tucked

Honors Day Attire:

 White oxford dress shirt along with khaki/navy/black pants

Outerwear

Scholars' outerwear must follow the school uniform policy at Wadsworth Magnet School. Jackets, sweaters, or sweatshirts must be solid navy, white or yellow. Any scholar who elects to wear a jacket with a hood may do so provided the jacket is in one of the WMS approved colors. At no time should the hood of the jacket be pulled over the heads of scholars.

Dress-Down or Spirit Days

Dress-Down/Spirit days for our scholars include jeans and spirit shirts only. Jeans must not have rips, holes, or tears when worn at school. *If the scholar does not dress down in accordance to this policy, the scholar is expected to be in school uniform*.

Spirit Days are Fridays of each week. In the event the week ends before Friday, scholars may observe the last day of the abbreviated week as a Spirt Day.

Prescribed Shoes: At Wadsworth Magnet School, our first school rule is to ALWAYS "Be Safe". Scholars must always wear appropriate and prescribed shoes. House shoes, flipflops, between-the-toe shoes, beach shoes, Crocs, athletic slides, Mules, Foam Style Shoes like Yeezy Foam or Bubble Slippers and the like are not considered appropriate for school; any shoe not approved for school, risks consequences for failure to follow proper uniform procedure. Proper footwear is essential for safety during all types of physical activity. Improper shoes can cause injuries. Shoes recommended and worn in Physical Education must be athletic cross trainers, tennis, court, or running shoes that Velcro or lace securely. See the images below. If your scholar's shoe choice does not align, the scholar's choice is out of the uniform policy. Shoe brands are not a consideration for compliance. Inappropriate footwear may lead to an alternate physical education assignment. Please help your scholar comply.
